<b>Entry Fee</b>	\$25, includes Mill Society Individual Membership, new or renewing (make checks payable to <b>Delaware River Mill Society</b> ;) Member benefits include: Evening Programs, History Lunches, Family Fun Picnic in August, annual Holiday Party and more
<b>Media</b>	The exhibition is open to work in all media
<b>Entry Limitations</b>	Entries are limited to 1 piece, 24 x 36 max. (including frame) plus two portfolio pieces
<b>Display Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All work must be wired for hanging</li> <li>Sculpture cannot exceed 100 lbs and must include a display pedestal</li> <li>Video/electronic installations must be self-contained and include all necessary equipment</li> </ul>
<b>Insurance</b>	Insurance is the Artist's responsibility
<b>Judging</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All work will be judged &amp; prizes will be awarded by the <b>Images of the Mills</b> Juror and will include the following awards: Purchase, Unique Use of Materials, Contemporary Significance, Interesting Site Interpretation, Seasonal Historic Interpretation, Best Abstract Interpretation, Public Use Interpretation</li> <li>A <b>People's Choice Award</b> will be given; only show visitors are eligible to vote</li> </ul>
