Stockton Visitors Center

Welcoming and information: Will serve tourists and visitors to the complex with Mill information on tours and history. Will also direct visitors to appropriate destinations in the area and regulations of D&R Canal State Park (i.e. proper boat launch instructions etc.). Volunteer will not leave the visitors center unattended for the duration of his/ her shift. Shifts are on weekends from 1-4 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Visitors Center is open June through October.

Grist Mill Volunteer Options

Docent: Share the history of the Prallsville Mills complex with visitors while guiding them through the site. This includes all mill buildings and the John Prall Jr. House museum. Docents will provide enthusiastic tours and encourage membership and donations to the Mill. Shifts are on Saturdays and/ or Sundays when the Mill is available for public tours from 1- 4 p.m. Docents may also be asked to be available by appointment for group tours during the week.

Curatorial Assistant: Assist in research and exhibit set up and to catalogue and preserve artifacts. Volunteer should be willing to work with the Mill Society's acquisition committee.

Landscape Assistant: Help keep mill grounds clear of trash, help identify and remove invasive non native plant species, keep up with other maintenance needs.

Library Volunteer: Serve as a reference or technical services volunteer in the Mill Society library. Assist in creating and managing the library. Technical assistants will work behind-the-scenes on special projects working with books, documents, photographs, or other unique historical materials. Should be willing to work with the Mill Society's acquisition committee

Special Events: Assist in the John Prall Jr. House museum open houses and at the Mill's annual Progressive Dinner, Holiday gathering, and other special events.
